

Its main goals:

- To promote critical thinking about the Internet between teenagers and for teenagers.
- •To create a safe and responsible culture of the social networks and other services.




Projects



How does the project work?

It was a contest in which the teenagers had to create a small video where they could express, on the different technologies, what were their points of view, perceptions, fears and opportunities.













Most problematic topics worked:

- Addiction and isolation
- Ciberbullying and discrimination
- Fear to be kidnapped
- Stealing private images
- Stealing personal data (passwords)





Results

- 3 editions of the contest (2009-2010-2011)
- 470 videos made by Latinamerican teenagers
- 4000 teachers trained face to face and through e-learning.
- More than 10.000 teenagers are now aware of the issue.

A little group of students and teachers work in a campaign to reach all the school students, teachers and families.


































JUST A CLICK AWAY

Promotion strategy of the safe and responsible use of ICTs and digital citizenship for Latinamerican young people.

The strategy is based on two main courses of action:

- a. The first one is a regional online campaign for raising awareness.
- b. The second one is an advocacy forum for teenagers from each country.







During the forums, more than 1000 teenagers

from 7 countries worked in workshops where they could debate on how technologies influence them.

They realized their opportunities and their risks, and could make a **MANIFIEST** with their commitment and petitions for adults who are responsible of protecting them.

RECOMMENDATIONS AND ADVICE

- We recommend our peers not to meet up with people they know only through social websites. Also to protect their accounts.
- We recommend parents to supervise the websites their children visit.
- We recommend our friends to be careful with the pictures they upload as they don't know what they can be used for.





COMMITMENT

- We commit not to get together with groups that support bullying on the Internet.
- We promise not to accept strangers' requests through the Internet, not to reveal our location or private information to strangers, to communicate online with our family and friends. Also, to use the Internet in an intelligent way as well as to inform if any cyber bullying situation comes up.
- We commit to denounce inappropriate content that appears on the Internet, to not produce them nor share them.





IDEAS

- There should be computers in every public school.
- Free wifi connection everywhere, including poor areas given the fact that Internet Access is a human right.
- The States should produce a legislation that controls publicity on the Internet.





REQUESTS

- We demand the authorities that our rights are respected and to provide public and private institutions with computers.
- We require help for young people to fight against cyber bullying and penalty for online offenders.





ICTs

- We suggest everyone seeing the Internet as a tool whose results depend on how we use it. Internet is not a bad thing; the bad thing is to use it in an inappropriate way. It's everyone's responsibility to promote a safe use of it.
- We have learned a lot about how ICTs can be used in an appropriate way. From now on, we accept the challenge of sharing our knowledge on the use of the ICTs with people that know less about the subject.
- Internet and social media are very important for getting to know a lot of things and get more involved with the Internet.
