In Indonesia, Child Advisory Committee (CAC) members of Time to Talk! - a global campaign supporting working children to take forward child-led advocacy for improving their working conditions and eradicating all forms of child labor - wrote a song and held an interactive dialogue encouraging adults to treat children better and support their dreams come true, despite being child workers. Following, they also screened a film produced by themselves. The film, *The Power of Niat*, is the story of a child who wants to help his parents improve their economic condition by finding a way to earn money and pay his school tuitions. Although his friends decide to leave school for economic reasons, he insists in going to school. The child-produced film came in sixth place in the Child Film Festival 2019.
