In Kenya, Child Advisory Committee (CAC) members of Time to Talk! - a global campaign supporting working children to take forward child-led advocacy for improving their working conditions and eradicating all forms of child labor - led a walk in the community of Homabay to create awareness about the importance of living in a community free of child labor, where working children can exercise their rights to light and limited work, to rest when sick, to age appropriate work, and their right to seek legal representation to protect themselves from abuse
