Sub-Saharan Africa: Uganda

In Uganda, over 1000 girls aged 9 to 14 from very marginalized communities have gone through educational training and then a solutions lab where they put forward their ideas as part of "Girls as drivers of change". Girls improve their approaches and once finalized they can apply for funding to implement their solution.
