In South Africa the informal work sector has grown since the beginning of the pandemic. One example is cosmetic representatives who visit households offering their products. Girls are training these representatives on violence and gender inequalities, so they're equipped to detect both gender-based-violence and violence against children. "Women and children see them constantly, as they're always the same home visitors. They now have the knowledge to offer referrals and advice".
