Sub-Saharan Africa: South Africa

In Argentina, Chile, Malaysia and South Africa, adolescent girls go through six-weeks extensive advocacy and communications training, including identifying the problems that affect them in regard to gender-based violence. Then they go to their communities and train groups of younger girls, so they can together develop advocacy campaigns. Training and campaigning happen through peer-to-peer engagement, and cascades information and learnings.
