To respond to COVID-19 Cambodian government has worked hard and issued many preventive measures such as closing schools, bars/karaoke, restriction on number of people meet (less than 10) and restriction on cross provinces mobility. To address these problem, CWCC has taken action as following: Meeting, Training and Awareness Raising: the project has consulted with local authorities to gather participants less than 10 for awareness raising and applied social distancing. Regarding child support groups meeting could be conducted due to Covid-19, so the project has gone directly to their houses, meeting children and their parents to provide counselling and build their understanding on child participation and parenting skill. During the visit, child support group members are able to share express their views related to Covid-19 prevention as well and how their e-learning program has been done while the school close. They have built their capacity in the e-group learning and how to discuss among their peers in the self-study.
