TdH's partner in Batam (Yayasan Embun Pelangi / YEP) has been assisting a children group called RAEKSA (stands for Teenagers Anti-CSEC) and a youth group called KOMPAK Batam (stands for Youth Community for Anti-Child Trafficking and CSEC) in awareness raising, and campaigns to educate their peers and local community on the issue of CSEC (including child trafficking and OCSE), and advocate with local government. Despite the Covid-19 pandemic they continue doing these activities through social media, create YouTube video education, vlog competition, workshop and festival to celebrate the National Children's Day. They also participated in workshops on reviewing the Child-Friendly City indicators with CSOs for advocacy to local government. Children are more distressed with online learning platform. Many from poor families with no/limited internet access, led to distress parents, particularly those who lost their income or jobs. Domestic violence cases tend to increase.
