In the Philippines, KKK Reina Fed, a child led organization has identified violence against children as a major problem in the country: 'Most children encounter violence here in our country. They are the ones that do not know their rights as children, they do not have the voice to speak up and do not know who to talk with.' (Aj Aizyll, adolescent member of the organization)

To address multiple forms of violence, the network has been focusing on transferring skills and knowledge to vulnerable children, creating spaces for them to talk to each other, support each other, and know more about their rights. 'This may help other children to type what they have in mind and to know more about their rights as children and to know more about the issues globally. I am very thankful that I have this opportunity as a child. I hope I learn a lot cause I want to share this with other children.'
