When most of the world went into lockdown as result of COVID-19, Restless Development, a youth-led global organization activated the "Solidarity meetups". Over 2000 people engaged, spanning over 100 countries across Europe, North America, South America, Asia, and Africa. The idea is to support young people to meet with others around the world – others they wouldn't typically have the opportunity to connect with – so they can share ideas and learn from each other and the different ways they are being impacted by or are responding to the pandemic. This was complemented by a youth-led campaign called "Feeling Restless", focused on sending adolescents and youth ideas of how to help others from home.
