With support from Children Rights and Violence Prevention Fund-Uganda we have implemented a COVID emergence relief fund on child safeguarding during the COVID-19 lockdown and have involved 12 adolescent girls in developing strategies for sensitizing 06 villages on violence against children, sexual and reproductive health rights challenges faced by girls and providing information on COVID-19 preparedness.

We also engaged the adolescent peer mentors in provision of information to girls in their communities and linking those faced with violence and challenged with SRHR needs to our clinic through our 24 hour service toll free helpline. Serving Lives Under Marginalization (SLUM)
