Children from Bangladesh, Bolivia, Guatemala, India, Indonesia, Kenya, Malawi, Nepal, Peru, Philippines, Senegal, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe participated in drafting and in the final review and editing process of the Joining Forces Policy brief:

"Children's right to be heard: we're talking, are you listening?"

Children participated in country group discussions for creation of the policy brief, and in the selection of peer selected who would participate in public event on Nov 20, 2020. They also peer selected who would participate in the private plenary and breakout sessions, and which children would lead the breakout sessions. They also decided which children would submit videos to be used and who would write the child authored blog. Now that the final version of the policy brief is available they are working at country level to determine if they want a child friendly version and what that means from their perspective, they are creating their own in-country advocacy plans.
