In Paraguay, Child Advisory Committee (CAC) members of Time to Talk! - a global campaign supporting working children to take forward child-led advocacy for improving their working conditions and eradicating all forms of child labour - held an interactive dialogue with local authorities to advocate for the rights of working children. More specifically, they met with representatives from the National System of Protection and Promotion of the Rights of Children and Adolescents in the Paraná region.
