Middle East and the North Africa: Lebanon

In Lebanon, Child Advisory Committee (CAC) members of Time to Talk! - a global campaign supporting working children to take forward child-led advocacy for improving their working conditions and eradicating all forms of child labour - are taking actions with decision makers, while mobilizing other working children. CAC members held meetings with Lebanese Parliament members, where they agreed to collaborate and expand their approach to other regions of the country (Beirut and the South of Lebanon), where child labour is an important problem that needs addressing. Children also distributed 100 booklets in Chouf, reaching other working children with further information to mobilize them to take action.
