Latin America and the Caribbean: Colombia

Within the framework of the response to the emergency due to Venezuelan migration to Colombia, a process of accompaniment and emotional care of children and adolescents is being carried out, even during the period of isolation due to COVID-19. The postman's strategy was activated, through which children would write letters about their experiences, and these would be answered by Save the Children staff. Telephone contact with children was also taken forward to maintain open communication with them.

The boys and girls members of our national participation network have continued their meetings virtually. They themselves have led contests and webinars on the protection of children's rights in times of pandemic. Some of these children have represented their peers in high level meetings.
