In Rwanda, Child Advisory Committee (CAC) members of Time to Talk! - a global campaign supporting working children to take forward child-led advocacy for improving their working conditions and eradicating all forms of child labour - held a public event with drama, songs and sketching, to amplify their advocacy messages on the urgent need to create a safe environment for working children. They transmitted to the public the importance of working children accessing health services and education, and proposed the key stakeholders that should be involved in the process. Different means like drama and singing were used to voice their messages to 'encourage duty bearers to do everything that makes children enjoy their rights'.
