Sub-Saharan Africa: Democratic Mali

In Mali, we produce interactive radio roundtables, funded by DANIDA, between youth and other marginalized groups and local authorities and security forces. The opportunity for dialogue reduces tensions around the movement restrictions put in place to prevent the disease's spread. The roundtables are aired across our network of partner radio stations. We also launched a Coron'Art Challenge in partnership with a local rap production studio, Zack Prod, inviting youth and artists to express themselves in a one-minute freebeat. The artistic outlet helps young people to stay connected during quarantine and promote prosocial, creative expression. Their performances are shared on social media, and the best performances will be awarded by Malian artists. The Coron'Art Challenge is supported in part by UNPBF.
